#### DANCE GENERAL INFORMATION – 2025-2026

\*PAYMENTS: THE MONTHLY LESSON FEE (CASH OR CHECK) IS A 'FLAT RATE' DUE THE

FIRST LESSON OF EACH MONTH! The Studio accepts cash or check. We have a locked mailbox outside of the studio, as well as a drop box located in the lobby under the viewing window. You can set it up with your Bank to have automatic checks sent. Payments made after the 10th of the month should include a \$5.00 Late Fee. Statements will not be sent unless you are past due! We appreciate your cooperation and prompt payments! Late Fee of \$10.00 - Lesson Fees carried into the next month (only allowed with arrangements made in advance!). NSF Charge: \$25.00. Full Session discount (10%) is due the First Lesson in September. Bi-Session discount (5%) payments are due the First Lessons in September & January.

- 30 Minute Lesson (Tots/PSB): \$50 Monthly; Bi-Session (Two payments of \$214); Full Session (One payment of \$405)
- 30 Minute Lesson (Pointe): \$35 Monthly; Bi-Session (Two payments of \$150); Full Session (One payment of \$285)
- 30 Minute Lesson (Hip Hop Only): \$50 Monthly; Bi-Session (Two payments of \$214); Full Session (One payment of \$405)
- 45 Minute Lesson: \$55 Monthly; Bi-Session (Two payments of \$235); Full Session (One payment of \$446)
- 60 Minute Lesson: \$60 Monthly; Bi-Session (Two payments of \$257); Full Session (\$486).
- 75 Minute Lesson: \$65 Monthly; Bi-session (Two payments of \$278); Full Session (\$527)
- \*Families with 3 children taking Dance Lessons: \$15 monthly discount. (Session discount does not apply).
- \*\*Students enrolled in Both Dance Combination Class & Tumbling: \$15 monthly discount. (Session discount does not apply).
- \*\*\*If More Than One Discount Applies to Your Family Pick your Best Discount Only One Discount Applies!!

<u>NOTE:</u> Registration fees, Monthly fees, Costumes fees, and Recital fees are Not Included in the Discounted Prices! All Dance Fees are non-refundable. Please contact Lori for any questions on dance fees (lori@adeltumblinganddanceclub.com).

CLASS DROP/CHANGE POLICY: If your child decides to discontinue lessons before the session is completed; please notify Sue Dunsmoor PRIOR to the beginning of the month they no longer plan to attend with a 30-day notice. Otherwise, once a student is enrolled, we assume they are continuing month-to-month throughout that session. If we have not been notified that a child is discontinuing, you may be billed for the month. This can minimize any fees you owe and may allow someone else to participate! Thank you! In the event a student needs to change classes, please let the Director know by the 20th of the month. Once the change request is processed, the account will be updated and any difference in monthly payment will be applied to the account unless otherwise instructed by the requestor. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated, can minimize any fees you owe, and may allow someone else to participate in Dance!

ATTIRE: Please make sure that your dancer is wearing the proper attire for their class. Girls: Any color leotard/biketard or tight fitting t-shirts/tanks, soffee/booty shorts, jazz pants/capris/leggings, and tights/socks.

Boys: T-shirt and shorts/pants. Please make sure that hair is pulled back away from the face (ponytail or bun for long hair; headband that won't fall off or clips for short hair). NO JEANS will be allowed to be worn during class - dancers will be asked to sit out of class if worn. If jazz pants are worn, they must not touch the floor and need to make sure they stay put without falling down. No Jewelry (necklaces, bracelets) - stud earrings are ok. If you have questions about the proper dance attire, please email me.

**REQUIRED DANCE SHOES:** Our required shoe list is located with Mark's Dancewear, 6212 Merle Hay Rd, Johnston, 515/270-0744 (Follow Merle Hay Road North of the Interstate. First parking lot after Walgreens on NW 62<sup>nd</sup>, on the left. Located in the basement.

ATTENDANCE: Please make sure that your dancer arrives, is dressed and ready to go with dance shoes on at the start of class time (do not have them wait until they come into the studio to put shoes on). This allows your dancer time for proper warmup as well as cuts down on distractions of late comers. All lessons must be paid for whether or not your child attends, as a place has been reserved for them. Students and their families are involved in many activities and conflicts may occur. Requests for make-ups seem reasonable to parents, but since we only offer 1 class time for each specific class, attending another class is not feasible. We would like you to make dance a priority as it is a team effort - just like any other sport. We would like it if dancers could rotate weeks as they are missing out on essential learning new dance steps. Thank you for your understanding.

\*\*NOTE:\*\* If your dancer did not attend school the day of dance class because they were not feeling well or started to not feel well after school, please be considerate to others and have them stay home from dance - the less we share the better for all.

**<u>RESTROOM:</u>** Please make sure that your dancer(s) uses the restroom prior to coming into the studio. This is to allow less distractions as well as the domino effect of once one has to go, they all have to go.

<u>WATER BOTTLES:</u> Please have your dancer(s) bring their own water bottle to class. Please mark dancer's name on the bottle.

**PARENTAL VIEWING:** Curtains of the studio viewing window will be open the 1st class of each month. We like parents to see the dancer's progress; however, classes are much more attentive and constructive when the curtains are closed! The door into the studio will also be closed during classes.

**BREAKS:** We take breaks that coincide with the Adel-DeSoto-Minburn (ADM) Schools. We still have classes when there are early outs or no school due to teacher in-service/professional development/conferences. If ADM School cancels or dismisses early due to inclement weather, lessons will be cancelled. Email will be sent out as well as updates on Facebook posted regarding cancellations.

**COSTUME DEPOSITS:** Costume deposit will be due with <u>October's tuition</u>. The remaining balance will be due in November during Costume Reveal week (November 10th, 12th, 14th - more information will be given at a later date). We will not know what the full price of the costumes will be until toward the end of October/beginning of November as prices will be dependent on costume chosen and prices change each year. The following will be the total deposit (per dancer) due for each class:

COSTUME REVEAL WEEK - COSTUME BALANCE DUE: Costume reveal week is when dancers/parents get to listen to the chosen recital songs and look at the chosen recital costumes. Dancers will start out in the lobby area and will be during your dancer(s)' regular class time and will start at the beginning of class times. Once this has been accomplished, dancers will go into the studio to start their class. Parents will then verify costume sizes, choose type/size of tights and pay the remainder balance of the costumes (you will be notified of the remaining balance once costumes are chosen/priced). More information will be coming out prior to this week. The reveal week will be:
